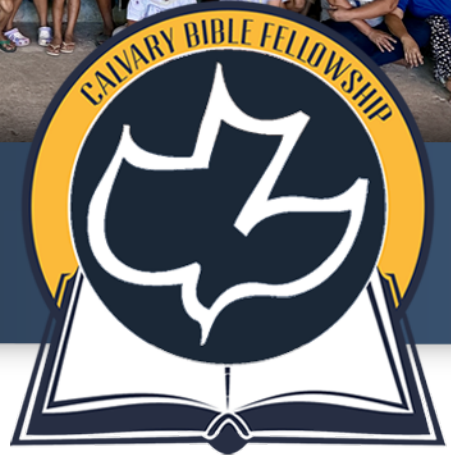

SUMMER CAMP

We were blessed to have a team of thirty come for a second year from Calvary Chapel in Iwakuni, Japan. They came to help with the Summer Camp for Simbahan sa Bukid and Calvary Bible Fellowship. It was an amazing four-day event overflowing with incredible games, inspirational worship, and powerful teaching as they took the youth through the book of Revelation. We had a glow night where we flooded the church with black lights and neon paint as the kids broke into teams and tried to pop LED-lit balloons. We had a day at the local jungle waterfalls, where the kids enjoyed the beauty of God's creation. The last day concluded with a bonfire on the beach as the kids sang praises to the Lord. But none of those things was the highlight. They were all just the warm-up.

On Saturday, we distributed Christmas Shoeboxes to almost 1,000 kids in the mountains. God has incredible timing. We had been waiting for over three months for the boxes to arrive, and the last of them finally came the very morning we were scheduled to hand them out. The joy on the faces of the kids who received the gifts is hard to describe. Their excitement was contagious as they eagerly clutched their precious boxes and heard the truth that the greatest gift of all was Jesus.

After handing out the gifts at the second school, the team was so moved that every one of the volunteers just started breaking out into worship and dancing. It was heartwarming to watch everyone give glory to God, with huge smiles on their faces, as they saw how the lives of the students had been touched. But that was still not the most amazing thing. God still had something even more incredible He wanted to do.

Jacob, from the team, shared a great message from Matthew 22 about being invited to the wedding feast. But what happened later that night was what really touched hearts.

The final event of the trip was a gathering of both

churches and the team at Splash Park. It was meant to be a night of fellowship and a way to say goodbye to the team from Japan. A handful of people—four in total—had asked about being baptized. So, as we gathered together, we gave a short message about the reason for stepping out and publicly declaring our faith in Jesus. Then it happened.

In the same place where God stirred hearts last year for over twenty people to step out and be baptized, God moved again. We did not baptize four people. There were forty-four who stepped out to declare their love for Jesus! For over an hour they came into the water, many of them weeping as they surrendered all to the Lord. The Lord was moving in that place in a way I had not seen since He had done so in the same place the year before.

Not that the place is special. Not that the timing is what matters. It is just a good reminder that the Lord wants to move. He desires to stir hearts. He wants to draw people to Himself. He longs to pour out His grace and love upon us. We just have to be willing, available, and ready to respond. Even if that means that sometimes, lightning does strike twice in the same place!
