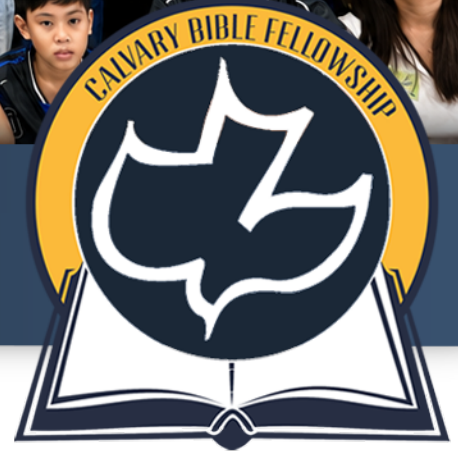

School Supply Outreach - Bulig sa Bukid will be hosting a School Kit and Hygiene Kit Distribution activity as we help children get ready for school.

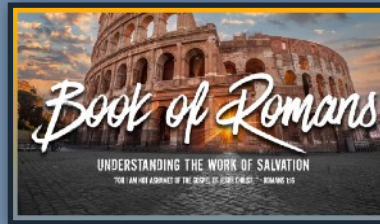
