problem at the church. The signal in the mountains was poor, so the details did not come through right away. Problems are a normal part of ministry, so at first we were not too concerned. But when the full message finally arrived, it was serious: we were going to have to leave the building by June 30. The church is not a building, but the church does need a place to meet! The following Sunday, we gathered with the leaders to talk through our options. As we discussed the situation, we realized that we faced two major hurdles, and we had no idea how either one would be overcome.

The first problem was that we did not know the owner of the building. We had always dealt with them through a third party. During the meeting, one of the men asked for her name and quickly sent a text. A moment later, a smile began to spread across his face, and everyone looked at him expectantly. It turned out that one of the interns working under him was the daughter of the building caretaker.

That connection opened the door for us to contact the owner directly and ask about leasing the property. Problem number one was miraculously solved!

The second problem seemed even more daunting. The owner was only willing to lease the entire building to the church - all three floors. That solved the problem of finding a place to meet, but it created a much larger one: the cost was far beyond what the church could afford. But, of course, that was not a problem for God. There were no announcements, no one had to say a thing, the Lord stirred the hearts of His people and the costs were all covered.

We read the stories in the Bible, and we believe they are true. But there is something remarkable about seeing God work so powerfully right in front of you. It is a beautiful reminder—especially because we forget so easily—that there is nothing impossible for our God!
